**DIRECTIONS**

---

UPON the Tribunal receiving a Notice of Appeal on 09 August 2021;  
AND UPON it appearing to the Tribunal that the Notice was received within the stipulated time limit;

**IT IS DIRECTED THAT:**

1. No later than on **26 August 2021** those representing the Olive Grove Foundation must explain the legal basis under which they believe that the “Olive Grove Foundation” is able to litigate. If the Olive Grove Foundation is not a company able to litigate, but litigation must be conducted by Trustees, those representing must state the name(s) of the Trustee(s) who bring this appeal.
2. The Charity Commission must send its Response by **28 September 2021**.
3. The Appellant may Reply to the Response; should they choose to reply, their reply must be with the Charity Commission and the Tribunal no later than on **26 October 2021 or, if later, 28 days after the Charity Commission’s Response is sent to them**.

4. The Charity Commission is to confirm any Secondary Disclosure (see Rule 29 of the Tribunal Rules) by **09 November 2021 or, if later 14 days after APPELLANT sends a Reply to them.**
5. Parties are to use their best endeavours to bring this matter to a hearing during the listing window of January to April 2022.
6. If any party considers that matters should be expedited, or that a Case Management Hearing is needed they must write to the Tribunal (copy to their opponent) and explain why.
7. The parties are to use their best endeavours to agree Directions based on the model paragraphs, which will be sent in a separate document. Parties' proposed directions are to be sent to the Tribunal by the date that the appellant is due to send their optional Reply (paragraph 2 above). If matters are not agreed by the parties at that date, the Tribunal will rule on them.
