UPON those representing the appellants stating that the trustees named above bring the appeal;  
AND UPON it appearing to the Tribunal that the Notice was received within the stipulated time limit;

**IT IS DIRECTED THAT:**

1. Mr Jacob Boruch Wolff, Mrs Ruth Wolff and Mr Yehudoh Aryeh Lobenstein are substituted as appellants (in these Case Management Directions they will be referred to as “the Appellants”).
2. The Charity Commission must send its Response by 10 June 2021.
3. The Appellants may Reply to the Response; should they choose to reply, their reply must be with the Charity Commission and the Tribunal no later than on **08 July 2021** or, if later, **28 days after the Charity Commission’s Response is sent to them.**

4. The Charity Commission is to confirm any Secondary Disclosure (see Rule 29 of the Tribunal Rules) by **22 July 2021 or, if later 14 days after the Appellants send a Reply to them.**
5. Parties are to use their best endeavours to bring this matter to a hearing during the listing window of October to December 2021.
6. The parties are to use their best endeavours to agree Directions based on the model paragraphs, which will be sent in a separate document. Parties' proposed directions are to be sent to the Tribunal by the date that the Appellants are due to send their optional Reply (paragraph 2 above). If matters are not agreed by the parties at that date, the Tribunal will rule on them.
