DIRECTIONS

IT IS DIRECTED THAT:

- 1. As Mr Hines has stated the reasons that he believes this Tribunal has jurisdiction, the Charity Commission is now directed to:
 - 1.1. Respond to the appeal; OR
 - 1.2. Apply under rule 8(2)(a) for the appeal to be struck out.
- 2. <u>The Charity Commission's Response / Application must be with Mr Hines and the</u> <u>Tribunal no later than on **08 September 2021**.</u>
- 3. If the Charity Commission applies for strike out, they should ensure that their application deals with Mr Hines' grounds, including his submission that:

The Charity Commission says on its website that if you think a decision of the Commission is wrong, then you have 42 days in which to appeal to the Tribunal and you should "Clearly say why you think the Charity Commission's decision was wrong".

4. If the Charity Commission does not apply for strike out, their response must consider all matters of case management, including whether this appeal should be listed to be heard with any other appeal involving the same charity/charities.
