APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO APPEAL**

Permission to appeal the decision is refused

REASONS

The appellant seeks to challenge a decision that does not dispose of proceedings; namely a decision not to strike out part of the respondent's case under rule 8 of the Tribunal Procedure (First-tier Tribunal) (General Regulatory Chamber) Rules 2009.

The grounds are misconceived. The issue is not at this stage whether there is evidence to support a particular stance but whether, regardless of any evidence, a party's case (or an aspect thereof) cannot realistically succeed on any view.

Paragraphs 27 and 28 of the grounds are wholly inappropriate.
