5. In the circumstances, it is not appropriate to proceed to prepare this matter for

a hearing until it is known whether there will be further appeals. The period of

adjournment gives the Appellants time to lodge further Notices of Appeal, if

they wish to challenge the further orders.

6. At the adjourned directions hearing, I will decide whether this appeal should

proceed to a hearing, or be stayed, whether any further appeals should be heard

sequentially (and if so in what order) or whether to hear all the appeals

together.

7. The parties are encouraged to agree directions if possible and to send them to

the Tribunal for approval.

8. I reminded Mr Swettenham and Ms King that they have been given details of
