DIRECTIONS

Upon the remittal of these proceedings from the Upper Tribunal following its decision of 5th December 2016 and after considering the Directions issued by the Upper Tribunal in that decision and having reviewed the written submissions of the Applicants and the Respondent it is directed that:

- (1) An oral hearing of the issues arising out of the application by the Applicants to be joined as parties to these proceedings will be held at the first available date in London. A half day will be allowed for the oral hearing.
- (2) At the oral hearing the parties may make submissions on the issues of whether to join the Applicants as parties to these proceedings and, in the event that this is agreed, whether the Tribunal should give permission to appeal the decision of The First-tier Tribunal of 8th January 2016.

- (3) The Tribunal understands that the Applicants and the Respondent have submitted all of their written submissions on both of these issues in the course of their submissions to the First-tier Tribunal following its decision, in their submissions to the Upper Tribunal and in their recent submissions to this Tribunal. In the event that any further written submissions are thought necessary, they shall be delivered to the Tribunal with a copy to the other parties within seven days of the date of these Directions.
- (4) The Appellant shall indicate within seven days of the date of these Directions if he wishes to play any continuing part in these proceedings. The Tribunal confirms, for the sake of clarity, that there is no need for him to do so.
