Upon the Tribunal receiving an application from the Respondent for a strike out of this appeal dated 16 October 2017

And upon the Tribunal raising a new ground for a possible strike out of its own motion

**IT IS DIRECTED AS FOLLOWS**

1. The Appellant is directed to provide any representations on the proposed strike out within 7 days of the date appearing below.

**REASONS**

2. The Respondent has applied for a strike out under rules 8 (2) (a) (“no jurisdiction”) and rule 8 (3) (c) (“no reasonable prospect of success”) for the reasons set out in its application of 16 October 2017.

3. The Tribunal also considers that it may be appropriate to strike out this appeal under rule 8 (3) (b) on the basis that the Appellant has failed to co-operate with the Tribunal to such an extent that the Tribunal cannot deal with the proceedings fairly and justly. This is in view of the Appellant's failure to make his submissions by 9 October 2017 in accordance with the Tribunal's Directions of 8 September 2017.
  
4. Before an appeal can be struck out, the Tribunal must give the Appellant an opportunity to make representations on the proposed strike out pursuant to rule 8 (4). I have directed accordingly.
