**THE TRIBUNAL ISSUES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS:**

1. A final hearing to determine the Appeal will be held between 21<sup>st</sup> and 31 July. The parties have agreed that this hearing will be decided by the Tribunal upon the papers and in the absence of the parties.
2. The parties are familiar with the remaining issues and arguments in this Appeal. A short timescale for submissions prior to the final hearing is appropriate and proportionate and was envisaged in the Directions issued on 14th June 2012.
3. On or before 11 a.m. on 12<sup>th</sup> July the Appellants shall make any further submissions in this Appeal to the Tribunal and provide a copy to each of the Respondents. These submissions should outline those changes that the Appellants seek to the form of the Scheme attached to the e-mail dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2012 from Veale Wasborough, which the Tribunal has been informed contains amendments agreed by all parties. The submission should explain why such changes should be ordered by the Tribunal and take full account of the Tribunal's Decision on a Preliminary Matter in this Appeal.

4. On or before 11 a.m. on 17<sup>th</sup> July, the Second and Third Respondents may make further submissions to the Tribunal, with a copy to the Appellants and other Respondents, outlining any reasons why the changes that the Appellants seek to the form of the Scheme should not be ordered by the Tribunal.

5. On or before 4 p.m. on 20<sup>th</sup> July the First Respondents may make further submissions outlining the reasons why the changes sought by the Appellants should or should not be ordered by the Tribunal and suggesting any improvements that may assist in the interpretation of the Scheme.
