DIRECTIONS

Further to the Directions of 25 January and 1 April 2016 and the parties having jointly requested these Directions

IT IS DIRECTED as follows:

1. The 25 January Directions are hereby varied at paragraphs 10 to 15 to read as follows:

10. **By 12pm on 5 May 2016**, the Appellant is to file its written submissions with the Tribunal and to serve them on the Respondent.

11. **By 5pm on 19 May 2016**, the Respondent is to file its written submissions with the Tribunal and to serve them on the Appellant.

11a. **By 5pm on 26 May 2016**, the Appellant may file further written submissions with the Tribunal and to serve them on the Respondent. Such submissions are to be limited to replying to points raised in the Respondent's written submissions. The Appellant is to notify the Respondent as soon as possible if it does not wish to file further written submissions.

Bundle of authorities and statutory materials

12. The parties are to use their best endeavours to agree a bundle of authorities and statutory materials, in accordance with the directions below. The authorities should only be those specifically referred to in the written submissions.

13. The first draft of the index to the authorities bundle is to be prepared by the Respondent and served on the Appellant **by 5pm on 1 June 2016**. The Respondent shall also serve electronic copies of all of the authorities on the index by that date.

14. The Appellant is to notify the Respondent whether there are additional materials that it wishes to be included in the authorities bundle and provide electronic copies of the authorities to the Respondent **by 5pm on 7 June 2016**.

15. A consolidated version of the authorities bundle is to be prepared by the Respondent and filed with the Tribunal and served on the Respondent in electronic form **by 5pm on 14 June 2016**.

2. The parties have permission to apply to vary these directions or to apply for further directions provided such application is in writing setting out the full reasons for the application and (where applicable) before the time limit for complying with the direction has been reached.
