DIRECTIONS

1. On 02 June 2021 Tahani A Hag completed a Notice of Appeal to lodge proceedings with this Tribunal.
2. On 21 June 2021 I sent him Case Management Directions which required him to identify the legal provision which meant that he lodged proceedings in this Tribunal rather a different Tribunal or in a court. I gave him until 20 July 2021 to identify the relevant legal provision and includes for his reference Schedule 6 to the Charities Act 2011 which lists the provisions which this Tribunal can adjudicate upon. He was told that, if he did not identify the provision, his appeal may be struck out.
3. By email sent on 29 July 2021 at 16:35, Mr Hag wrote to the Tribunal:

*Thank you very much for kind attention our appeal has received. As I mentioned last time the Charity Commission has started to revenue our complaint in the last month as I told in our last request. I was hoping they will come back to us because we want to give them the benefit of the doubt. We have sent an email to urge them with the reference number and we are waiting.
May I kindly ask for more time, say until 31/08/21.*

I am expecting them to answer by that time.

May I take this opportunity to thank you for the patience you have shown throughout this episode

4. On the information provided thus far, it appears to me that Mr Hag does not, as yet, have the right to appeal to this Tribunal. As he chose to come to this Tribunal rather than go to a different legal forum he must have some idea of why. I do not consider it appropriate for him to be given more time to identify why he came to this Tribunal as I consider that he should be able to immediately to that.
5. The request for more time is refused.
6. Pursuant to rule 8(3)(a) of the GRC Rules, the appeal is struck out.
