**Refusal of Permission to appeal to the Upper
Tribunal**

1. Ms Simpson completed and Application for permission to Appeal to the Upper Tribunal, it was received at the Tribunal on 04 August 2021.
2. I have considered whether to review the decision I made to refuse to extend the time limit for Ms Simpson to appeal and I do not consider it appropriate to review.
3. I have considered whether to grant permission to appeal to Ms Simpson and I refuse permission to appeal. Permission to appeal can only be given if there is an identifiable error of law.
4. As previously explained, the Tribunal is a creature of statute, it can do what Parliament has given it power to do. Parliament has not given this Tribunal power to consider appeals against "Stage 2 Reviews" conducted by the Charity Commission.

5. Ms Simpson has the right to apply direct to the Upper Tribunal Tax and Chancery Chamber, for permission to appeal; such application must reach the Tax and Chancery Chamber within 1 month of this decision being sent to him.
