## DIRECTIONS

The Tribunal having received a Notice of Appeal on 31 January 2020, referring to a decision refusing to grant the Appellant a waiver in relation to her proposed trusteeship of the above-mentioned charity dated 20 December 2019

And the Appellant having applied for an anonymity direction, pursuant to rule 14 of the Tribunal's Rules

## **IT IS DIRECTED THAT:**

- 1. The parties are invited to make submissions on the question of whether an anonymity order should be made. The parties may be assisted by the Upper Tribunal's Decision in *D v Information Commissioner<sup>1</sup>*. They may also be assisted by the Supreme Court's judgment in *Khuja v Times Newspapers Limited*<sup>2</sup>.
- 2. The parties are invited to make their submissions by no later than 5 pm on 24 February 2020, following which the Tribunal will issue its ruling having considered the matter on the papers, unless either of the parties requests an oral hearing.
- 3. Until the Tribunal has made its ruling, the Appellant is not to be identified in any public-facing document by the Tribunal or by the Respondent.
- 4. The Respondent need not send its Response to the Notice of Appeal until the Tribunal has issued its ruling and any further Directions.
- 5. The parties may apply for these Directions to be varied or discharged.
