CASE MANAGEMENT NOTE

1. Upon preliminary consideration of a notice of appeal presented by Mr Joseph Ackerman on 31 August 2017, it does not appear to me that the appeal concerns a decision, direction or order of the Charity Commission which is capable of being appealed to the Tribunal. I am therefore proposing to strike out the appeal on the ground that the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction in relation to the proceedings.
2. The Tribunal may only hear appeals against the decisions, directions or orders of the Charity Commission that are listed in column one of schedule 6 to the Charities Act 2011 (as amended). The schedule can be found by following this link: <http://www.legislation.gov.uk/ukpga/2011/25/schedule/6>
3. Mr Ackerman does not appear to have identified a decision, direction or order of the kind described in the schedule. Before deciding whether his appeal should be struck out, however, I shall afford Mr Ackerman the opportunity to clarify the basis on which it has been made.
4. Accordingly, I direct that, by 22 September 2017, Mr Ackerman must provide the Tribunal with a copy of the decision, direction or order being appealed and identify the relevant entry in the schedule conferring jurisdiction on the Tribunal in relation to it.

5. In the meantime, the Charity Commission is not required to file a response to the notice of appeal.
