IT IS DIRECTED

1. That this matter is to be listed for an oral case management hearing before myself on the first open date after the Reply and Secondary Disclosure;
2. The case management hearing may be vacated on receipt of a joint application if the parties are able to agree Directions beforehand.

REASONS

3. The parties have been provided in the usual way with the Tribunal's draft case management directions. These provide a standard framework for the steps required to bring all appeals to a hearing. Unfortunately, the parties have been unable to agree these.
4. The Appellant's non-legally qualified representative has renewed his novel application for disclosure to be directed by the Tribunal prior to the close of pleadings.
5. The Respondent complains that the tone and content of the Appellant's representative's frequent e mails are unprofessional and unacceptable and has asked the Tribunal to intervene. I hope that this will not be necessary.
6. In these regrettable circumstances I consider it fair and just to direct an oral case management hearing at which I can deal with all these matters.
7. Meanwhile, I remind the parties of their obligation to co-operate with the Tribunal and assist it to meet the overriding objective.
